Sub: **Transfer of Registration u/s 46A of the Dentists Act, 1948.**

I am directed to inform you that the General Body of the Dental Council of India, in its meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> September & 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2016 considered the email dated 27.09.2016 from Dr. Shiv Sharan, regarding the transfer of registration from one State Dental Council/Tribunal to another State Dental Council/Tribunal, u/s 46A of the Dentists Act, 1948, be processed immediately so that the candidate can be registered without any delay and both the State Dental Councils/Tribunals shall send information to DCI to update the Indian Dentists Register u/s 18 of the Dentists Act, and after some discussion and deliberation, decided as under:-

"The General Body of DCI reviewed the prevailing procedure of issuance of NOC for transfer of registration u/s 46A of the Dentists Act, 1948 and found that as per the practice prevailing in the DCI, on each and every occasion of issuance of NOC, the examination and scrutinize of all the documents like recognition of BDS, qualification, marksheet, internship completion certificate, it take considerable time, Consequent thereupon, the issuance of NOC for transfer of registration always get delayed and the applicant dentist suffers. As such, procedure is complicated one for the sole reason that all these requirements are already verified by the respective State Dental Council/Tribunal at the time of their first registration and this is merely the transfer of registration which does not require any scrutiny or examination of the papers. As per 46A of the Dentists Act, 1948, DCI is obliged only to issue NOC for transfer of registration and not concerned with other formalities

In view of these peculiar circumstances and in order to cope with inordinate delay in issuing NOC and also to simplify the procedure, General Body decides that a comprehensive certificate to the following effects shall be issued by the respective state dental council/Tribunal.

*It is certified that after having verified of all the documents of BDS qualification, Dr. \_\_\_\_\_ has been registered under part-A with the State Dental Council/Tribunal as per provision of the Dentists Act, 1948, on \_\_\_\_\_ with registration No. A- \_\_\_\_\_. The applicant dentist possesses the recognized dental qualification and eligible for registration or to continue her/his registration under the relevant provision of the Dentists Act.*

*2. She/he vide her/his application dated \_\_\_\_\_, now, requested for transfer of her/his registration form this State Dental Council to \_\_\_\_\_ (name of the transferee State Dental Council/Tribunal) and for the said purpose S/he surrendered the Original Registration Certificate on \_\_\_\_\_ issued by this Council. Therefore, this State Dental Council has no objection for her/his transfer from this State Council/Tribunal to \_\_\_\_\_ as per u/s 46A of the Dentists Act.*

*3. No disciplinary proceedings are pending or contemplated against him/her. There is no due/recovery is pending from him/her.*

*4. This NOC is valid only for 6 months from the date of issuing by this State Dental Council/Tribunal for the purpose of transfer of registration u/s 46A of the Dentists Act, 1948.*

*5. The name of the applicant shall be deemed to have been deleted from the register of transferor State Dental Council/Tribunal, the movement of the transferee State Dental Council/Tribunal register the name of the dentist after DCI issues its NOC u/s 46A of the Dentists Act.*

DCI without any further delay and after having satisfied the veracity of credential of the candidate and genuineness of the certificate issued by the respective State Dental Council/Tribunal shall immediately issue NOC to the applicant dentist so as to enable her/him to get herself/himself transferred and registered from one State Dental Council/Tribunal to another State Dental Council/Tribunal. However, DCI may not insist any state dental council to dispense with any requirement under their regulation framed by any state dental council u/s 55 of the Dentists Act, 1948. DCI shall consider the application only for issuance of NOC u/s 46A of the Dentists Act, 1948."

The decision of the General Body of DCI be circulated to all the State Dental Council/Tribunals for framing the guideline and shall be uploaded on the Website of DCI for Public Information."

The above decision of the General Body is being communicated to you for your information and necessary action.

Further, I am enclosing herewith a copy of Revised Proforma for Transfer of Registration from one State Dental Council/Tribunal to another State Dental Council/Tribunal as prescribed by the Dental Council of India for your ready reference. The concerned applicants are required to furnish Revised Proforma for transfer of registration to avoid any delay in processing their application at Dental Council of India, New Delhi.
