

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

This is to inform to all the concerned that the Dental Council of India (DCI) with the prior approval of the Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi has made 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment in the "DCI Screening Test Regulations, 2009" which has been come into force from 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 (date of notification in the official gazette) according to which no person (Indian Citizen/OCI/PIO Card holders) shall be eligible to obtain "Eligibility Certificate" from DCI for doing his/her foreign UG/PG dental qualification unless he/she has qualified the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET). It is mandatory for the person seeking admission for doing UG/PG dental qualification from foreign dental institution/university, to qualify the NEET before obtaining Eligibility Certificate.
